<u>CIRCULAR</u> CME's/TRAINING/WORKSHOP

To update the knowledge of our Medical/Nursing & paramedical staff we are planning to organise CME,s on regular basis on issues of paramount importance related to Health/Admn./establishment which will benefit all & ultimately will lead to better patient care& hospital services. Dr. Sanjivini Nodal Officer (CME) along with her link officers will organise it on monthly/quarterly basis or as frequently as needed in co-ordination with different wings of the hospital. The following points are to be taken care off.

- 1. All Officials for which the CME is meant must attend & a record for this shall be maintained.
- 2. Speaker to be from our own hospital but if need arise we can arrange speakers from other hospital/organisation as per existing rules.
- 3. Training may be for one day/two days or more as required/needed. If CME arranged through pharmaceutical company, must see that there is no product promotion and MCI guidelines are followed.
- 4. ACLS/BCLS/First Aid Training/BMW Training to the concerned will be the part of CME programme.
- 5. An induction programme for new batch of 'SR's/'JR's shall be held as soon as they join the department.
- 6. Nodal Officer shall prepare a schedule of such training /CME in advance with Date, Time, Venue, Speaker, Topic and target audience.
- 7. Light refreshment shall be provided by the competent authority.
- 8. There will be a Pre & Post Training Evaluation to assess success of the training programme.
- 9. I/C Care taking to arrange the conference hall and to see that AC /Lighting/Cleanliness/Audio Video System/Projectors etc. are functioning.
- 10. Case Presentation, achievement by a department/current issues and matter related to advancement in the field can be the part of the CME.
- 11. A hard copy of the CME may be circulated to all the participant & may be compiled inform of booklet for future reference.

- 12. Make the programme brief, interesting with fact and figures, having documentary video and practical tips of day to day importance.
- 13. Nodal Officer CME, may also see feasibility of arranging some training programme/workshop/observing functioning of departments/branches at other hospitals i.e. AIIMS, LNJP, CNBC/Pvt. Hospitals for imbibing the best practices of other hospitals.
- 14. Best CME/Workshop/Training programme shall be awarded yearly /6 monthly with trophy/certificate.
